Membership

F 30

3 of 4 clubs have added 5 or more new members. F30 has 96 members over 4 clubs. One club has under 20 members. Surprising to see TM4PM with 15 members as they have had more attendance in meetings I have attended since I started (late) in this role. They are still functioning strong with 3 goals met.

As of today (October 16), four out of five active clubs successfully signed up four new members.

F14

4 of the 6 Area 14 clubs are struggling for members. However these clubs have also had from 1-3 new members join their club.

DCP Goals

F 30

All clubs have provided projections for reaching a level of distinguish; non-so far have attained this level. One club has met 4 goals; two have met 3 goals and one has met 1 goal to date.

F 17

One of the high-performing clubs (Fun Speakers) met the membership & DCP goals to be a distinguished club, and is also eligible for the Go-Getter award recognized by District 99.

F14

It may be very difficult for the Y Club and Ag Lib to reach their level of distinguished as they have very few members and have been having a difficult time building members.

Two other high-performing clubs (University and College Plaza) are progressing towards their DCP goals. Area Director will encourage them to achieve five DCP goals before January 31 so that they can also be recognized as Go-Getter clubs.

Club Officer Training

speech contests were successfully held on Thursday, September 15, at the University of Alberta. All five active clubs in the area participated in the contests as contestants, functionaries, and judges.

Had a successful contest. Held in Sherwood Park at the United Church. Division F speech contest was successfully held on Saturday, October 15, at the University of Alberta. All Area Directors in Division F except for one participated in the contests as judges and functionaries.

Had a wonderful Area 14 speech contest held on September 21, 2016 that was hosted by the Pursuers Club. 5 out of the 6 clubs sent participants with all 6 clubs providing volunteers to fill the roles.
