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District 99 Bylaws - Boundaries

To adopt the Standard District Bylaws for District 99 effective July 1, 2016, with Article V Boundaries defined as follows:

"The geographical boundaries of this district shall be as follows: the northern portions of the Canadian provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan where the western, northern and eastern boundaries are the official borders of the two provinces and connect to the southern boundary of the district as follows:

In Alberta: From the British Columbia border directly east to the junction of Highway 93 and Highway 11. East on Highway 11 to Highway 22. South on Highway 22 to Highway 54. East on Highway 54 to Highway 590. East on Highway 590 to Highway 56. North on Highway 56 to Highway 12. East on Highway 12 to the Saskatchewan border, and includes all communities on this boundary

In Saskatchewan: From the Alberta Highway 12 south along the Alberta and Saskatchewan border to the South Saskatchewan River. East along the South Saskatchewan River to Highway 19. North on Highway 19 to Highway 15. East on Highway 15 to Highway 20, and then directly east along the projected line of Highway 15 to Highway 9. North on Highway 9 to Highway 5, then east on Highway 5 to the Manitoba border, and excludes all communities on this boundary"
