
PRE-REQUISITE TO USING DISTRICT 99 SERVICES

### Getting Access

- District Management Team
  - Provided an account in the form <a href="mailto:first.last@d99tm.org">first.last@d99tm.org</a>.
  - Includes DD, PQD, CGD, AM, FM, PRM, IPD and Webmaster.
- Area Directors
  - Requires Microsoft Account.
  - This should be associated with an email address you want to use for Toastmasters business.

#### Microsoft Account

- Microsoft Accounts are free!
- Go to <u>https://account.Microsoft.com</u>
- Options
  - Use an existing email address
    - Caution: work email addresses often don't work.
  - Create an @outlook.com email address.
    - For example: I created <u>walker.rglenn.d99@outlook.com</u> as the account I use for testing.

## Email Support


- District Management Team
  - Each get a license which includes mailbox, calendaring, storage for files and other services.
  - Includes DD, PQD, CGD, AM, FM, PRM, IPD and Division Directors.
- Area Directors
  - Email alias set up which will forward email to a mailbox of your choosing.
  - Area##@d99tm.org can be given to clubs and will forward email to appropriate area director (where ## is the area number).

### Public Web Site – d99tm.org


- This site is accessible by all members of the district.





    - Portal web site




#### Microsoft Teams

- To get started, I recommend you download and install Microsoft Teams.

  - Tablets
- Installation available at <u>https://teams.Microsoft.com/download</u>




## Logging In

- District Management Team
  - Enter your <u>first.last@dggtm.org</u> login name followed by your password.
- Area Directors
  - Enter your Microsoft Account as you login name and your password.



## Joining the Team

- Join the team.
  - If your ID has been used for multiple teams, you need to select "District 99 Toastmasters (Guest)" as the team you want to log into.
- Once you are fully logged in, you should see a window that looks like the one to the right.



### Your Team Memberships

- District 99
  - Everyone automatically added to this team.
- District 99 Leaders
  - Everyone who is working to make the District successful.
- District Executive Committee
  - All voting members of the District Executive Committee

- Division X Team
  - Your specific Division.
  - All the Area Directors, Assistants that are part of your Division team.
- There are other teams that you won't see but are there to facilitate collaboration for specific groups.

#### Zoom

- District has a Zoom account to use for District sponsored meetings:
  - Examples:
    - District Council Meeting which could have large number of participants.
    - Club Officer Training which again has to support large numbers of people and breakout sessions.
- Zoom helps us overcome the limitation of 250 participants which Teams has for interactive meetings.
- Not available for other uses.
